




Accomplishments - Data

- **EPOXI**
 - Peer review of Hartley flyby data on 15 Aug
 - 11 Datasets, ~0.5 TB (+1 non-EPOXI dataset)
 - All datasets certified but need lien resolution by 13 Sept due to wording of PMDAP ****Discussion****
- **Asteroid Datasets**
 - Peer review on 31 May
 - 18 datasets, most certified but one requires major revision
- **Stardust NExT**
 - Data from Navcam, DFMI, CIDA delivered by SDC
 - Under internal review, peer review probably in October
- **Rosetta**
 - Data at Steins flyby fully archived from all orbiter instruments except VIRTIS; released late June



Accomplishments - Other

- **Ferret 2**
 - New Comet/Asteroid search tool
 - Version 1 demo will be in PDS booth at DPS
- **SBN Website**
 - New website (format and organization)
 - Deployed publicly 19 Aug
- **NASA Challenge**
 - NASA HQ proposed SBN as host of NASA PDS Challenge for this year
 - Single, large data collection with many types of data
 - International Halley Watch
 - Challenge closed (i.e. proposals due) 12 Aug
 - Awaiting selection of winner – chosen 22 Aug



Problems

- **PDS 4**
 - Drain on staff
- **Rosetta**
 - No data from VIRTIS
 - No data submitted by any instrument at Lutetia (July 2010)
- **Фобос Грунт = Phobos Sample Return**
 - No success in arranging PDS4 training
 - Launch 11 Nov
- **Dawn**
 - Lien-resolved data from Mars flyby (Feb 2009) not yet delivered – FC being submitted for Delta-Review, VIR, GRAND TBD
 - Vesta data not scheduled for delivery until 6 months after departure from Vesta, *i.e.*, in 2013
